Branch turns 100 years old! Established in 1859, Lapeer's first library (originally called the Ladies Library) was shuffled between various locations around the city. The effort to find a permanent home for the library was largely driven by the ladies of Lapeer County who, with the help of local Lapeer Judge and Congressman Louis Cramton, were able to secure a grant for \$13,750 from the Carnegie Library Association. The ladies then



as a playground and football field. Once funds were found, the new building went up relatively fast and the community was invited to its first open house on New Year's Day 1923. The library was still missing one thing...books to check out! The building would not open for operation until February 1923. The first library card was issued on February 20, 1923 at the first story time held at the branch. In 1981, the library was renamed to honor Lapeer native and Newbery award-winning author, Marguerite deAngeli. In 1984, an addition was added to become the building we know and love today. 



If no copies of a Flex title are available, you can place a hold on the item to reserve your spot in line. In addition to hoopla, LDL users in the library's digital service area also have access to Libby, another eBook and eAudiobook service. Libby's collection works similar to hoopla flex; if there are no copies available of a title, you can place a hold on the item and will be notified when it's your turn to borrow it. Libby users receive 12 checkouts at any given time that you can use on a collection of thousands of
