Art panels are placed on both sides of Nepeessing Street, from the Marguerite deAngeli Branch Library to the PiX Theatre. Use the clues on the panels to find all the animals. The scavenger hunt is designed to start and end at the deAngeli branch.

Nature on Nepeessing was a collaboration between the City of Lapeer, The Lapeer Downtown Development Authority, and the Lapeer District Library. The artwork of Nature on Nepeessing was brought to life by Lapeer local Lapeer artist, author, illustrator, and librarian, Shelby Saelens.
