Library Lapeer District Library Welcomes Stephen T. Banister as New Director

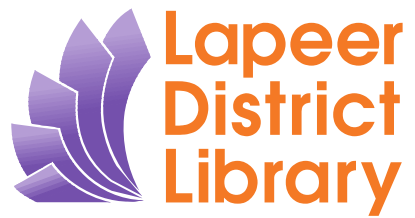
