

## LCCF Grant Awarded to deAngeli Friends

The Friends of the deAngeli Library received a \$1000 grant from the Lapeer County Com-



munity Foundation (LCCF). In November, the LCCF ran a promotion where anyone who donated on Giving Tuesday would be put into a drawing. 25 names were drawn and those people were allowed to select a non-profit to receive a \$1000 grant. Jill Lyons was chosen as one of the lucky 25 and selected the deAngeli Friends of the Library as the grant recipient. In line with our donations to the library being used for programming, the grant will be used for the creation of family activity kits by the library staff. Kits for stargazing and birdwatching are already being developed. Library patron families will be able to borrow the kits, which provide all the necessary supplies for the special activities. Awesome!
