## Library Millage Renewal

Lapeer District Library's current millage will expire in December 2022. This millage allows the library to operate and provide services, materials, and programs to the Lapeer Community. The renewal will be on the ballot August 2, 2022.

The proposed millage is a renewal and will be for .8653 mill for five years. Townships that will be voting include: Arcadia, Burlington, Burnside, Deerfield, Elba, Hadley, Lapeer (including the city), Marathon, Mayfield, Metamora, Oregon and Rich.

This millage renewal is for operating expenses only and not for a new library.
