## Join us at our Community Read Open House Saturday, October 8

Join us this **Saturday, October 8** for our Community Read Open House at the deAngeli Branch Library. Local author Bill Anderson will kick off the event at 2 p.m. with an author talk on his book, Michigan's Marguerite de Angeli: The Story of Lapeer's Native Author-illustrator. During the program, Anderson will share stories from his time with de Angeli and her connection to the Lapeer area. Anderson is an incredibly accomplished author; his anthology includes biographies about Laura Ingalls Wilder, Mark Twain, the Von Trapp family, and more.

Following the author's talk, light refreshments will be served and attendees are invited to take a tour of the library. A special collection of de Angeli's artwork and memorabilia will be on display throughout the building.

Free copies of the Community Read book, Michigan's Marguerite de Angeli: The Story of Lapeer's Native Author-illustrator will be available during the program while supplies last. Over 300 copies of the book have already been given out. de Angeli's popular book, Copper-Toed Boots will be available for purchase from the Lapeer County Historical Society. Each copy of Copper-Toed Boots will be \$17, cash and check only. There will be limited copies of both books, first come first served.

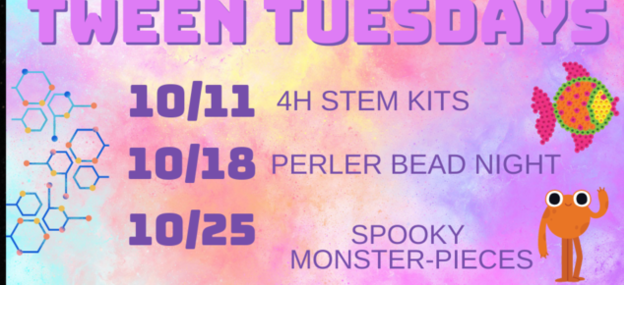
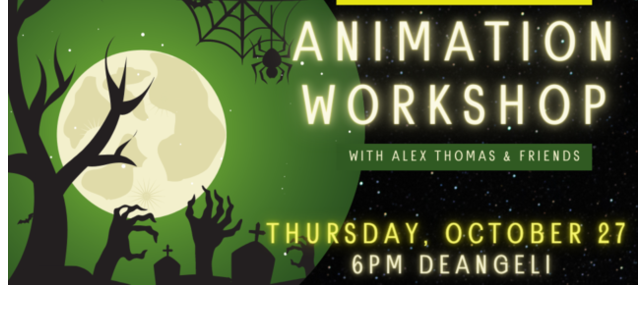


## Pizza & Pages
