### Year Books

Lapeer Schools only. From 1908, most years.

### Oakdale

Cemetery map and index, including residents donated for anatomical studies. Binders containing newspaper articles, not indexed but in chronological order. Also some maps, photos, census lists, and employee newsletters.

### Lapeer County Plat Maps & Atlases

25 different years from 1874 up to current.

### Newspapers Clippings

1879 until the 1990's arranged by subject.

### Genealogical Books

For reference with some available to check out. Includes miscellaneous Lapeer County indexes, family genealogies, and histories. Some State of Michigan and United States genealogy books.

### County Press

On Microfilm for most years from 1879 to 2008. Digital copies are available for 2009 to current.

### Brown Funeral Records

Index with images on Microfilm.

### Lapeer County Cemetery Index

Indexed by family name up to 1996.

### Lapeer County Phone Directories

For most years. Incomplete from 1927 to 1967, all years from 1967 to present.
