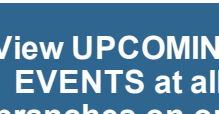

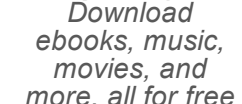

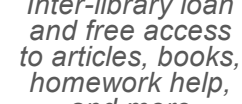

The Friends of the deAngeli Branch Library will pause on accepting donations during the winter months. No donations accepted at any LDL branch after November 28. The final two Donation Days are scheduled for Saturday, November 14, and Saturday, November 28 from 10-2 p.m., weather permitting or until the trailer is full, in the deAngeli Branch Library parking lot. Donations will not be accepted at any other time.



As a reminder, the Friends accept clean, fresh-smelling items in good condition. They do **NOT** accept magazines, condensed books, vinyl records, textbooks, encyclopedias, or dictionaries. Those dropping off donations must load items into the trailer themselves.

LDL Looking for Two New Board Members in 2021

Due to the resignation of two valuable board members, two board seats will be open in January 2021. The terms are for a duration of 4 years. The first individual must reside within Lapeer Township in order to be eligible for appointment and the second must reside within the townships of Arcadia, Burlington, Burnside, Deerfield, Elba, Hadley, Marathon, Metamora, Oregon, or Rich.

The LDL board is a seven-person governing board, with the responsibility for maintaining the public library for LDL, establishing library policies, employing the Library Director, adopting an annual budget, and approving the expenditure of funds. The regular board meetings occur on the third Thursday of each month at 5:30 p.m. Not only is this volunteer opportunity rewarding, it is also a great chance to have a hand in shaping the future of LDL and the Lapeer community.
